The purpose of study is to determine the relationship between nurses' workload and the implementation of hospital management information systems in the hospitalization room of Anna Medika Madura General Hospital.</i></p> <p><i>The research design used was cross sectional analytic.the population 30 respondents with a sample of 28 respondents.the independen variable was Workload of nurses with implementation of hospital management information system (SIMRS). Data collection techniques using questionnaire sheets Workload and SIMRS Implementation, Data analysis was carried out using the sperman rank correlation test. This research has been carried out Ethical Clearance tested.whith No: 2351/KEPK/UNIV-NHM/EC/XII/2024</i></p> <p><i>The results showed that those who had a moderate workload with sufficient SIMRS implementation were 15 (53.6%). The results of the spearman rank correlation test p value = 0.000 and r = 0.766 means that there was relationship between nurse workload and implementation of hospital management information systems in the hospitalization room of Anna Medika Madura Hospital.</i></p> <p><i>Poor SIMRS implementation will also affect service user satisfaction which will certainly affect hospital quality. One of the consequences of the lack of nurses implementing SIMRS, if the nurse's workload is excessive, it will affect their performance and delay the collection of reports in each unit that has implemented SIMRS. This study suggests increasing knowledge that can be done through programs such as SIMRS implementation training.</i></p>
