

ABSTRACT

Febrile seizures are one of the diseases or emergency conditions that are prone to be experienced by children, especially toddlers. The ability of parents to provide first aid for febrile seizures in toddlers refers to their knowledge and skills in recognizing the symptoms of febrile seizures and taking appropriate initial actions to prevent further complications. The purpose of this study is to analyze the relationship between parental knowledge and first aid for febrile seizures in toddlers in Kampak village, Geger district, Bangkalan Regency.

This study used a correlation analytic design with a cross sectional approach. The independent variable was parental knowledge and the dependent variable was the ability to first aid febrile seizures in toddlers. The population in this study were families who had toddlers who did not understand about first aid for febrile seizures in toddlers as many as 53, the sample was 47 respondents. The sampling technique used simple random sampling, data collection using a questionnaire, while the statistical test uses spearman rank.

Based on the results of the spearman rank statistical test, the p value (0.003) $< \alpha$ (0.05) means that there was a relationship between parental knowledge and the ability to first aid febrile seizures in toddlers in Kampak Village, Geger District, Bangkalan Regency. With a correlation coefficient value of 0.429 , it means that the correlation level was sufficient.

Based on the above explanation, it is recommended that future researchers analyze other variables related to febrile seizures in toddlers.
