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THE RELATIONSHIP OF THE ROLE OF CADRES AND FAMILY SUPPORT WITH THE PROVISION OF COMPLETE BASIC IMMUNIZATION AT THE POLINDES ROBATAL SAMPANG

ABSTRACT

Immunization is a strategy to strengthen or improve a person's immunity when they are actively responding to certain diseases. Based on the preliminary study on 26 november 2024 there were 46 infants aged 1 year. It was obtained that 19.57% (9) babies did complete basic immunization and 80.43% (37) babies did not do complete basic immunization. The purpose of this study is to determine whether there is a relationship between the role of cadres and family support with the provision of complete basic immunization.

The research design used quantitative with cross sectional approach. The independent variable was the role of cadres and family support and the dependent variable was complete basic immunization. The population taken was mothers who had babies aged 1 year. The number of samples taken was 41 data on mothers who had babies at Polindes Robatal Sampang. Sampling technique (free version) simple random sampling technique. data collection using questionnaires with lambda statistical tests. The research ethics were approved by KEPK Noor Huda Mustofa University No. 2668/KEPK/UNIV-NHM/EC/V/2025.

The results showed that most of the cadres were inactive 68.29% and most family support did not support 56.10%. The results of the lambda statistical test showed that there was a significant relationship between the role of cadres and the provision of complete basic immunization of 0.002 with a <0.05 so it was concluded that the p value = $0.002 < 0.05$. While the relationship between family support and the provision of complete basic immunization was 0.037 with a <0.05 so it was concluded that the p value = $0.037 < 0.05$.

Efforts made to overcome the problem of cadres providing counseling on the importance of immunization, and the importance of family support to mothers to provide immunization to babies.
